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Poll of The State of Georgia

August 3, 2022 – August 7, 2022

Surveys were conducted via live phone calls and interactive voice response phone calls. The sample consists of the users of landline and mobile phone numbers selected by random digit dialing. Except for primary races, results are weighted by demographic information with iterative proportional fitting. Note that some respondents refused to answer some demographic questions.
